3 THE COMMUNITY IMPACT FUND

UWBC currently funds 52 programs in Brazoria County through collaborations with 32 community partners, giving back over \$2mil to the community this year.

Last year, UWBC donors funded over 800,000 services through UWBC community partner programs and helped a whopping 70,536 residents through the Community Impact Fund.
