


PILLARS OF IMPACT TOTALS

we partnered last year with 13 local programs to provide 52,660 income services to Brazoria County children, vouth and adults.

UWBC also provides financial stability classes across Brazoria County. These classes provide attendees with the tools needed to make financially responsible decisions. We use real-world examples to teach the basics of banking, saving, and consumer rights.
