VITA RETURNS TO ASSIST RESIDENTS WITH 2018 TAX SEASON

JANUARY 17, 2019, BRAZORIA COUNTY, TX – The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers free tax help to households that earned \$55,000 or less in the previous year, persons with disabilities and limited English speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their own tax returns. VITA is a financial stability initiative supported by United Way of Brazoria County.

At VITA Sites, IRS-certified United Way volunteers provide free, basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing to qualified individuals.

This tax season marks the 12th year VITA has been available to residents of Brazoria County. Last year, VITA volunteers helped residents save \$57,434 in total refunds, \$10,499 in Earned Income Tax Credits (EITC), and \$16,283 in Child Tax Credits.
